

## 1929 Grand E.M. Skinner Symphonic Concert Organ

### Music in the Museum

One of Cincinnati's best kept secrets, the 1929 Grand E.M. Skinner Symphonic Concert Organ sits quietly near the entrance to the Robert D. Lindner Family OMNIMAX® Theater for guests to admirer. Many visitors walk by the console in its case and think it is simply a relic. Little do they know the magical music it can make!

Prior to the Union Terminal restoration, the 1929 Grand E.M. Skinner Symphonic Concert Organ was the centerpiece for *Music in the Museum*, a concert series hosted three times a year at CMC. During the restoration (July 2016 - November 2018) it was discovered many of the mechanical parts of the organ within the walls of the Rotunda were not up to code and in need of maintenance and repairs. With repairs complete, we look forward to sharing the glorious sounds of the organ with our guests as we bring back *Music in the Museum*!


